## Grade 2 Math

## Grade 4

The following supplies need to fit in a pencil box:

- box of 24 crayons (not 8,16 or 64 but 24 )
- set of thin markers (not thick) (set of 8 are best)
- scissors
- 4 good erasers (not the ones that go on pencils)
- 2 red pens
- 2 blue pens
- 2 highlighters

All items must fit in the pencil box. Please send the specified items and amounts. We have found that having more than the given amounts become distracting. Please conserve! We will send home anything that does not easily fit into the box.

Other materials:

- 3 boxes of Kleenex
- 1 canister of Clorox wipes
- a $11 / 2$ - 2 inch thick 3-ring binder (NO BIGGER OR SMALLER) with loose leaf, 3 hole punched, wide ruled paper AND 3-4 separators (for taking and holding notes)
- $\mathbf{1}$ composition book which will serve as a creative writing journal
- $\mathbf{4}$ folders labeled Math, LA/English, Science, Social Studies
- box of \#2 pencils (sharpened if possible)
- 4 glue sticks
- ruler with both inches and centimeters
- 1 plastic accordian-style folder with dividers. This is to take home loose papers and corrected work (a large TrapperKeeper style is too big, get something reasonable, as it will hold papers and your child's assignments)
- notebook only
- $\mathbf{1}$ ream plain white paper (I will use this paper to make my large squared graph paper for Math as standard graph notebook squares are too small)
*Please note that pencils, erasers and glue sticks will be collected and put into a community bin for use - fancy or special items are not recommended.
*Some supplies such as paper, pens, and pencils might have to be replenished throughout the year.


## Grade 5

Please bring the following supplies on the first day of school. Replace items as they wear out or run out. Thank you so much for your support.

## The following supplies are for your child's individual use:

- 1 - backpack with shoulder straps
- 1 - stylus pen for the iPad (rubber tip is best)
- $1-1$ ", solid color, 3-ring view binder
- 1 - package 5 tab dividers for binder
- 1-3 pack of binder pockets
- 1 - pencil box, solid color
- 1 - book downloaded onto their iPad to read in class

The following supplies should be put into the pencil box:

- $2-.7 \mathrm{~mm}$ mechanical pencils (plain, no decorations please)
- 1 - small pair of scissors
- 1 - good eraser (not the kind that go on the end of pencils)

- 2 - yellow highlighters
- 1 - box markers ( 8 basic colors only-no scented markers)
- 1 - Sharpie fine-point marker, black

- 1 - ruler indicating inches and centimeters
- 1 - box of oil pastels (25-color set only)

- 1 - large container of Clorox Cleaning Wipes
- 3-boxes of Kleenex
- 1 - Hand Sanitizer
