Confirmation Expectations for Year I & II

- Attend the 5:30 p.m. Mass during every Confirmation Sunday gathering. Mass is part of
 the session and is mandatory that candidates attend as a group. Mass is a fundamental
 and central part of our faith as Catholics; this is our opportunity to receive the Body and Blood of
 Christ. It is a very important part of our preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation.
- Attend all sessions throughout the year. Please inform Elsy ahead of time if you will miss
 a session. Arrangements must be made for make-ups.
- Participate in one interview with the Youth Minister in Year I and one interview with a priest in Year II.
- Attend a Confirmation retreat each year. It is very important that you participate in the
 <u>FULL</u> retreat time in order receive the full experience. If you are unable to attend our
 retreat, you must attend another parish's Confirmation retreat.
- Attend one Youth Day each year: Santa Barbara or Los Angeles.
- Participate in Parish Leadership: Confirmation Masses by being either a reader, altar server, singer, usher, gift bearer, musician, singer or greeter. Parish events/activities by assisting with the following: middle school youth group, high school core team, youth lector, pumpkin Mass, Parish Christmas Party, Christmas Eve Mass, Christmas Day Masses, Palm Sunday Masses, Holy Week/Easter Masses, 1st Communion Retreat, 1st Communion Mass, or Corpus Christi Feast Procession. All candidates are required to complete 6 activities/events total by the end of the 2-year process.
- Participate in a 2 service projects each year. Can be completed through high school but
 verification must be submitted to Elsy.
- All candidates <u>must</u> choose a sponsor and saint name during their first year of preparation.
- Parents need to volunteer at least once throughout the year. There are various ways to
 contribute to the program to help make it successful! Parents and sponsors are asked to
 attend the Masses during the Confirmation sessions to support candidates on their
 journey.
