From the Pastor

My Dear Parishioners,

R.C.I.A. (the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) is a process of taking a closer look at the Catholic religion for those adults who were not raised in the faith yet find themselves drawn to learn more about it. It is also for those who may have been baptized Catholic but have not received their sacraments in the Church.


During the process, the group informally come together for evenings of discussion, questions, and to wonder how we are being called to live the Gospel.

During certain Sundays of Lent, the people going through the RCIA process participate in three successive rites called "the Scrutinies." As moments of prayer, these rites, with roots dating back to the early Church, take place during the Mass.

For the rest of the Christian community, we unite with the RCIA candidates in spirit, praying for them and supporting them. It is also an opportunity for us to consider significant moments in our lives, not as accidents or coincidences, but rather as God intervening in our lives when we least expect it.

As pastor, it is always a blessing for me to welcome people who are on a continuous journey of discovery about their faith, their God, and their spirituality.

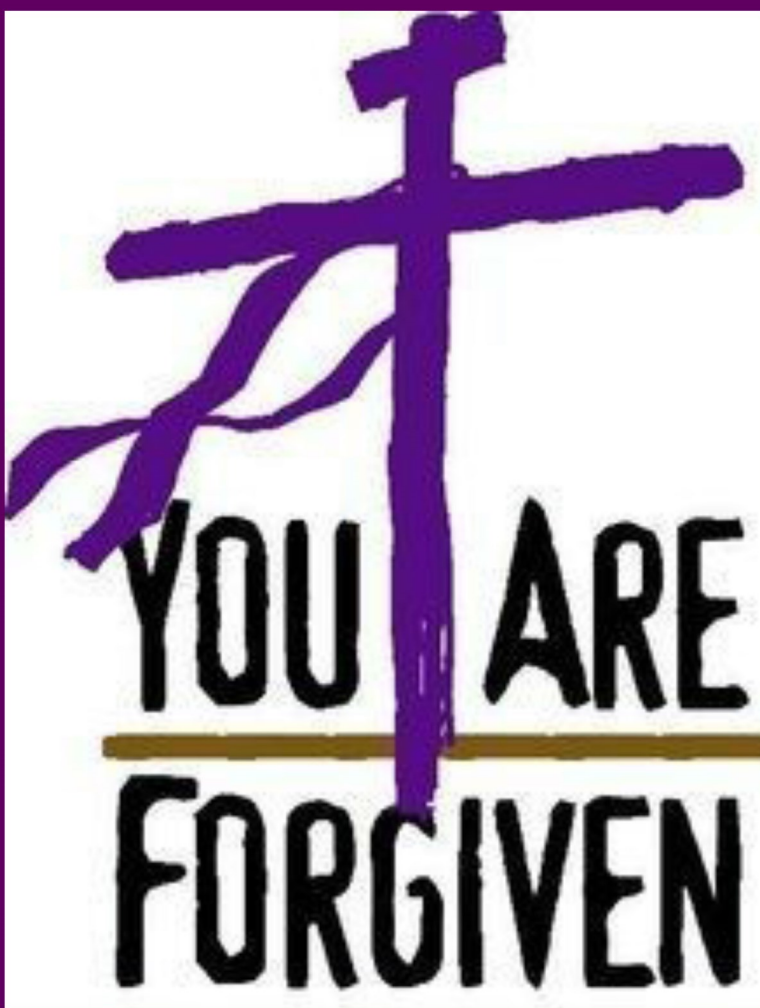
